# Membership

Although, in the easy going way in which most Band business is conducted, we have not chased registration or membership dues, registration and membership dues do exist! **Registration** is once and forever, and covers your access to insurance cover for some instances should anything untoward happen on a Band event, and access to Spond or other forms of communication.

**Membership** is an annual fee of \$10 per member, which covers voting rights, day to day electricity and water at the Band Hall, etc. Considering that most activities cost about \$15 per session, joining the Griffith City Band leaves you in the black, and thus possibly able to make a further voluntary contribution that would help keep paper in the photocopier, snacks in the Junior Band box, and make a start on Trevor's back-pay.

Registration and membership dues can be paid in cash to the Treasurer, or by EFT to the Griffith City Band bank account (NAB): BSB 082 632 Account Number 796 056 922. Please, please put the name(s) of the Band member(s) in the reference field of your transaction.

### Spond

Spond is a free app that the Band is using to communicate to and between band members. It is great for alerts to rehearsal times changes, notice of performances (gigs), play lists for gigs and many other uses. It is available on Android and iOS platforms, and can be attached to either an email address or your phone number.

Use of Spond is particularly helpful for Trevor. If you can use Spond to say whether you will be attending rehearsal then he is able to plan rehearsals, which gives us better use of his time. For instance, he may decide we need to work on a piece in which your instrument is a vital part. But if your entire instrument section doesn't turn up that night, and no-one tells him, he's wasted his time, and will have to change plans on the spot. And unless he knows you are going to turn up, that extra help may never happen, which is frustrating for everybody else who wants to play that piece well.

Please, if you can, use the Spond app. It's not an irritating piece of technology, it's a tool to help our Band improve. Setting up a Spond account is simple — or if you do have problems, just ask Trevor.
